NATIONAL ROLLER SPORTS ASSOCIATION, www.nationalrollersportsassociation.org, in conjunction with Skate City Sports, announces the 2026 Tom Osborne Rink Hockey Invitational to be held Friday, May 29 - Wednesday, June 3, 2026 at the Pepsi Roller Sports Arena in Colorado Springs, Colorado, USA.

Sanctioned by the NRSA, the event invites elite rink hockey players and clubs from the USA and multiple countries. Divisions include Adult Gold, Silver, and Bronze, plus all Youth – 8u, 10u, 13u, and 15 years & under. “The Tom Osborne Invitational provides the best test for Rink Hockey’s elite talent, with high caliber referees enforcing international rules,” says Jim Jost, Director of Rink Hockey for NRSA.

In its 6th year, the annual event is named after the former Colorado Springs Sports Corporation leader Tom Osborne, and honors his legacy to the city and the sport community he helped create. All athletes and participants 18 years of age or older must be certified through the U.S. Center for SafeSport, and be registered with the NRSA. In accordance with contemporary head protection protocols, the NRSA requires all players in all age groups to wear helmets.

The Pepsi Roller Sports Arena is a 28,000 square foot dedicated roller sports facility, featuring hardwood maple and stilmat flooring, stadium seating, HD scoring and video monitors, mezzanine level bar and restaurant, main level concessions, full team locker rooms, and an onsite equipment and maintenance shop. “We strive to offer development opportunities for rink hockey athletes at all levels. And the Tom Osborne Invitational is the culmination of this goal,” says Emanuel Garcia, Skate City Sports Director of Rink Hockey.
