NATIONAL ROLLER SPORTS ASSOCIATION, www.nationalrollersportsassociation.org, in conjunction with Skate City Sports, announces the 2026 Walt Frazier Inline Hockey Invitational to be held Saturday, June 6 – Sunday, June 14, 2026 at the Pepsi Roller Sports Arena in Colorado Springs, Colorado, USA.

Sanctioned by the NRSA, the nine day event brings together elite inline hockey teams from across the United States. Divisions include all Youth - 8u, 10u, 12u, 14u, 17 years and under, plus Adult divisions - Tiers I, II of 35yo and 45yo & over. "The Walt Frazier Invitational continues to provide high level hockey competition for athletes of all skill levels from every corner of the country," says Kendall Curtis, nationally acclaimed Inline player and NRSA Board member.

The 4th edition of the event is named after inline hockey pioneer Walt Frazier, whose industry commitment and leadership drove inline hockey growth through the 1990s and 2000s on both the domestic and international stage. All athletes and participants 18 years of age or older must be certified through the U.S. Center for SafeSport, and be registered with the NRSA. In accordance with contemporary head protection protocols, the NRSA requires all players in all age groups to wear helmets.

The Pepsi Roller Sports Arena is a 28,000 square foot facility featuring hardwood maple and stilmat flooring, stadium seating, HD scoring and video monitors, mezzanine level bar, restaurant, main level concessions, full team locker rooms, and an equipment maintenance shop. "The Walt Frazier is the top inline hockey tournament on our annual calendar, and we deliver every enhancement available: digital scheduling, state of the art scoreboards, and first-rate referees," says CJ Yoder, Director of Inline Hockey for NRSA and Skate City Sports.
